3-Day Engagement

The 3-day engagement enables you to be exposed rapidly to standard Microsoft Exchange Server 2007 SP1 Architecture and Deployment planning methodology. Most of the content of this engagement will be delivered through a series of interactive technical sessions, covering most aspects of an Exchange Server 2007 deployment. During these sessions, you will have the opportunity to map individual product features to your environment, through interactive discussions with your Exchange Consultant.

At the end of this engagement, you will have gained knowledge of the key features of Microsoft Exchange Server 2007 SP1 and how it might integrate into your environment. You will also be provided with a customized roadmap for planning the next steps of your Exchange Server deployment.

5-Day Engagement

The 5-Day engagement is an extension of the 3-Day engagement, with the addition of an Exchange Server 2007 leave-behind lab, and extended time for the Strategy & Planning workshops. The leave-behind lab will be based on two Virtual Machines, and will be used to demonstrate product functionality and execute customer scenarios such as transitioning users from Exchange 2003 to Exchange 2007.

This engagement is recommended for small or medium organizations, considering a transition from Exchange Server 2003 to Exchange Server 2007.

10-Day Engagement

The 10-day engagement does not include the 5-day offering, and must therefore be considered as a separate item, which can be offered alone or in combination with the 5-day engagement. The intended audience for a 10-day engagement is directed to Technical and Business decision makers. The 10-day engagement will drive the customer through the envisioning process for an Exchange Server 2007 infrastructure deployment, and transition from Exchange Server 2003.

As part of this engagement, the delivery consultant will conduct a series of requirements gathering workshops and interviews with the customer, which will contribute to the elaboration of a high-level Vision/Scope document. These workshops will target different groups of stakeholders and will collect information about business, functional and technical requirements. The requirements include consolidation considerations, administrative practices, service and operational level agreements, compliance, client access, backup and disaster recovery. This engagement focuses on capturing only key requirements and major components of the existing environment. The more detailed requirement gathering will be conducted if customer decides to proceed with Exchange 2007 design.

At the end of this engagement, the customer will be presented with a Vision/Scope document

15-Day Engagement

The 15-day offering is the combination of the 5-Day and the 10-Day offerings.
